**Privacy Notice**

**How we use Visitor Information**

Under General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) we are obliged to inform you of the information we hold on you, including what we use it for, who we share it with, and for how long we keep it.

We, Prior Weston Primary School and Children's Centre, 101 Whitecross Street, London, EC1Y 8JA are the Data Controller for the purposes of data protection law.

The categories of information that we collect, hold and share include but are not limited to:

- Name
- Company/Institution Details
- Vehicle Registration Details
- CCTV images
- DBS Details
- Photo ID

**1. Why we collect and use this information**

The purpose of collecting and processing this data includes but is not limited to:

- Fulfil our legal obligations in relation to Keeping Children Safe in Education
- Inform our operational procedures
- To comply with the law regarding data sharing

**2. The lawful basis on which we use this information**

Our lawful basis for collecting and processing staff information is defined under Article 6, and the following sub-paragraphs in the GDPR apply:

- (c) Processing is necessary to comply with the legal obligations of the controller.
- e) Processing is necessary for tasks in the public interest or exercise of authority vested in the controller (the provision of education).

**3. Storing your data**

Your data will be stored in the Electronic signing in system for 1 year then removed and held in a secure filing system for 6 years before being destroyed..

**4. Who we share information with;**

We routinely share information with appropriate third parties, including:

- Our auditors, to ensure our compliance with our legal obligations
- Police forces, courts, tribunals

**5. Requesting access to your personal data and your Data Protection Rights**

Under data protection legislation, you have the right to request access to information about you that we hold, through a Subject Access Request.

- Give you a copy of the information in an intelligible form
- Rectify incorrect or inaccurate information.
